Celery leaves have a strong flavor, but chopped finely go well in a salad. Other than that, **wash / clean** and trim the leaves of any stem, then put on a plate or platter to dry. The top of the refrigerator works **good / well**. When they're completely dry, store them in an airtight container away **from / on** light, then use them to season soups or stews, or to make celery salt. To **do / make** celery salt, just crush a few leaves in a small container, add salt to cover, put a tight lid on and store in a dark place **for / since** one to two weeks. Remove the larger celery bits if you prefer before using.
